Sunset Palliative Care Inc. (SPCI), is a
non-profit, charitable organization
providing compassionate care to
individuals living with a life-threatening
illness. Trained and dedicated volunteers
offer comfort, emotional support and
practical assistance to clients. Referrals
to the program may come from the
individual, their family, health care
professionals, or friends. SPCI support
is available whether the individual
resides at home, in hospital, or
personal care home. There is no cost
to the patient or their family.

Palliative Care rooms in Portage hospital
have been furnished and equipped by
SPCI. The rooms offer a comfortable,
quiet and homelike space for patients and
family. The organization financially
supports a bereavement group, helps a
camp for bereaved children, and provides
funds to the City Library for the
purchase of books on bereavement and
palliative care. A salary is paid to the
coordinator of the program and SPCI
funds ongoing training and education of
the Sunset Palliative Care Volunteers.

Financially the program relies solely on
donations and fundraising.
